4: **Review of the 2019 Age Groups and Championships led by AJ**

Letter of thanks and feedback from Mark Norton chair Truro City and on their behalf. Very complimentary regarding the running of the galas and thanks given to all the various roles concerned. Caroline Trestrail particularly identified for her excellent assistance on poolside re. results, finalists.

Feedback – considerations for next time:

- Sat 9th Finished early however Sun 10th very late with various consequences – perhaps move 100 breaststroke to Sat afternoon & 200 Fly to Sun afternoon
- Could then perhaps run a junior and a senior ‘skins’ event after the event prize giving to ensure people stayed for the **main prize giving** on the Sunday.
- During the final prize giving ceremony, perhaps move the trophy table to the starting end of the pool rather than leaving them in the corner, as it is impossible for spectators to see past the crowd that forms directly in front of the medals table, and people in the stands can’t hear what is happening.
- The warm ups were different than normal which made it quite difficult to monitor a large number of swimmers across multiple lanes. I’m not sure about the feedback from other clubs regarding splitting swimmers into age groups by lane rather than by club, but it meant that swimmers were trying to do very different warm ups in the same lane leading to a reduction in the effectiveness of the warm up. Perhaps lane allocations based on the numbers of entries per club per session could be considered, with the coaches then able to choose how to use their own pool time to best effect?
