### **Acting Comp.Sec/ Counties Report for 15/01/2019**

#### **County Distance events**

Warm ups based on entry times, except for one swimmer – who was moved prior to warm up. Both coach and swimmer were happy. With a maximum of 51 swimmers for 800 and 39 for 1500, easily sorted.

Also, this affects both distance and counties – an issue has been ref. club a swimmer entered under that is with the Management Board.

#### **County events – main body**

Warm ups based on ages. Sessions 8 (9.02.19) and session 10 (10.02.2019), will need to have 4 x 15minute warm up sessions – due to pool operators only wanting 72 swimmers in the pool at any one time.

Entries are comparable with last year, up 2 additional swimmers and only 25 entries down overall.

#### **Interclub**

Two dates were available            23/03/19 – which clashes with Surf lifesaving

25/05/19 – which is at the beginning of half term

Proposal for next year Run the 800m and Interclub on the same day. Do the distance in the morning, and the Interclub in the afternoon. Reducing the need to book out pools and officials. Any suggestions?

#### **Rule changes**

The County rules have been amended, and for those that have seen the Intermediate Meet Pack, will see that they now cross reference with the County Rules – any that do not apply have n/a against them. Standardised – made simpler.

#### **Intermediates 2019**

Times set as the same time as last year. This was due to 60 days being required for licensing (tonight for Intermediates), and the fact that it had to go to region before that. No chance for it to come to swim committee before the license and meet pack went off.
